WHITE PINE SHRINE CLUB, A CLUB OF ELF KHURAFEH SHRINE CENTER LOVE TO THE RESCUE FOR CHILDREN ON THE SINRISE SIDE

#### WHAT'S IN A NAME?

In 1634 a ship load of New England white pine logs were sent to mother England to provide masts and spars for the Royal Navy. White pine trees, growing as tall as 150', being light, strong and resilient enough to withstand nature's tumults were ideally suited to rig the navy that ruled the world! By 1652 white pine was the premier mast making material. As a result the King decreed that all white pine trees of 12 inches or more growing in the colonies were the property of England. A tool resembling an adz with a point was used to imprint the King's broad arrow mark and the trees no longer belonged to individual landowners in the colonies.

After 121 years of this imposition the growing cadre of entrepreneur lumbermen providing the timber to build a new nation grew increasingly vexed by the edict and they organized a revolt. They abducted the King's tree marking soldiers and were summarily arrested and brought before the crown's court. A sympathetic judge levied a fine of £20 and released them with stern admonishment. Word spread of their audacity and a party rumored to be Masons, inspired by the lumbermen's tactics, cast chests of tea into Boston Harbor! (or harbour as it was then spelled). The rest, as they say, is history!

The white pine was and is a valued commodity in our area of Michigan and aptly gave its name to our club. Just like the white pine trees, Shriners stand tall and support the "rigging" or motivating forces which provide the finances for children in need of orthopedic and burn healing at the Shrine's 22 hospitals. "No man stands so tall as when he stoops to help a child!" That's what White Pine Shrine Club is all about!

#### WHO ARE THESE GUYS?

The camaraderie and fellowship inherent in being a Shriner provide a fulfilling and rewarding experience of raising funds to help children grow up to lead a full life. You have seen our kids on TV explaining what Shrine has done for them and you have seen us in our Fezes selling Shrine papers and onions and riding our float in parades and putting on concerts. You may have attended one of our circuses, watched our clowns perform or watched a precision motorcycle team. Shriners bring the talents and resources God has given them and provide awesome medical treatment for children in our communities and they have fun doing it!


