


Each pint of blood we collect can help save up to three lives

A numerous collection of folks upheld Lady Laura's desire to ensure the food selections were allergy friendly and clearly marked (gluten free,


nut free, soy free, contains shellfish, etc.).


Greetings Nobles,

Just a quick message from the Membership Committee. As a temple, we the Membership Committee need the help of everyone. The program the temple is offering Nobles who were suspended for NPD (Non Payment of Dues) to Pay a fee of \$100 and be reinstated current is working. The program is still going on, however its now \$110. Be watching your email and Facebook for updates on membership. Progress. After suspending Nobles the end of last year who were

3yrs behind on dues. Elf Khurafeh began 2022 with 878 members. This trend cannot continue.

However something I learned at membership school, there's a solution to every problem. Several temples are having membership issues, while some are not. Some ideas that have helped other temples rebound we've started. Clubs/Units, reach out to your members that are not active. If they're behind, consider the Club/Unit paying. Another program is similar to the Sunshine fund we used to have but had not money; this one's called "Adopt a Brother". You are able to pay another's dues. Some of the ones suspended are life members who only owed Per Capita and Hospital Assessment. In some cases, they owe just Per Capita. Brothers, Charity starts at home; so let's lend a hand. The Divan Ladies and volunteers worked incredibly hard on their first 2022 fundraising project, *Circus T-Shirt Sales*. With only a few weeks notice of the circus date and venue changes, the Ladies all jumped in to action. For 2022, the



ladies agreed to buy the supplies and design them using a cricut and vinyl. The impressive sales gave a profit of \$2,500+ with 250 shirts. The Flint venue of seven performances sold 212 shirts, while the Saginaw venue of only 5 performances nearly matched it with selling 210 shirts. Miscellaneous sales may continue if anyone missed the opportunity to get their shirt.



Shirts were available in seven colors and six designs, one including Clown of the Year - Husky. Sizes were offered in 0-3 month onesies for \$10 increasing in to adult 3x for \$20.

The manual labor, purchasing supplies and designing these shirts truly is the backbone to their profit. Nancy Siedmiorka spent many late nights cutting the vinyl in preparation for the event. About 200 shirts were ready

when the sales started Friday in Flint. Each day, more shirts were purchased, vinyl cut, designs picked and the final products pressed. Thanks to the various folks who stepped up at both venues to get shirts out on the tables. Many thanks to David Benn and his Civil Air Patrol Cadets, Brien Fox, Illustrious Sir Todd Clayton PP, Jared Julien, Riley Fox, Rene Downing, Diane Zelmanski, Jan Dougherty, Carol Noye, Lisa Brack, Emily Harvey and many others that worked behind the scenes.


All Circus volunteers are invited to our Circus Appreciation Dinner!



Dear Illustrious Sir,

Shriners Children's Ohio is seeking Associate Board Members to join their Board of Governors.

If you have a Noble that is interested in contributing their specific skills per the current Hospital and Rules and Regulations, Article 5, 105.1 Membership, (5), Article 5 stating:

(5) Nomination. In January of each year, the Chairman of the Board of Governors shall contact, in writing, the Potentate of each Shrine Temple that sponsors the Hospital (with copies to the Recorder of each such Shrine Temple and all members of the Board of Governors), soliciting nominations for all anticipated vacancies which occur on the Board of Governors at the end of that calendar year. The Recorder of each such Shrine Temple shall promptly distribute/publicize this information to Temple Membership in the Temple newsletter and any other applicable application requesting nominations for anticipated vacancies on the Hospital Board of Governors. The letter will specify the requirements and professional skills or experience necessary or desired for selection as a Board of Governors member, and will enclose a copy of the Job Description for Board of Governors Members approved by the Board of Trustees. All nominations accompanied by the required application form are to be submitted to the Nominating Committee of the Board of Governors not later than May 1 of that year. The Nominating Committee of the Board of Governors shall evaluate all nominees and determine those who meet the qualifications of the membership skills list, above, and select from those qualified the individuals whose skills and experience will satisfy the current and/or anticipated requirements of the Board of Governors. The Nobles selected by the Nominating Committee of the Board of Governors shall be asked to participate in in-person interviews, at the Hospital, to be conducted by the Nominating Committee. The Nominating Committee of the Board of Governors shall then make its recommendations for nominations to the Board of Governors. Upon approval of those recommendations by the Board of Governors, the nominations shall be forwarded not later than September 1 to the Chairman of the Board of Trustees, with a copy to the Executive Vice President, for approval by the Board of Trustees.

We ask that your recorder disseminate this information to the membership of your Temple via Newsletter, etc. Any interested parties should ask their Divan to submit a letter stating their interest to serve along with their qualifications. These letters should be forwarded to:
