Labor Day Bridge Walk

Date: Monday, September 4th, 2017

Cost: \$52.00 per person

Departure: 2:00 a.m. from Clio K-mart

Status: Some seats still available!

Walk the Mackinac Bridge with thousands of other people on Labor Day. Avoid the hassle of driving and waiting in lines to take a bus across the bridge. Your payment will reserve your seat. We will stop for a bathroom break on the way and breakfast will be included at the rest area. We'll cross the bridge and you will walk south to Mackinaw City and then have time to shop, have a good meal, and we'll meet at 2:00p.m. and head south to Clio. We arrive home about 6:00 – 6:30 p.m.

*** Due to changes made by the Mackinac Bridge Authority, the bridge will be closed to traffic beginning at 6:30 a.m. on the day of the walk until noon. Our options are to go as usual and join the lines and ride the school busses over the bridge to take part in the walk OR we leave an hour earlier to ensure that we arrive before 6:30 a.m. so we can cross the bridge in our own bus. Since the advantage of taking the bus to Mackinac is **not** having to stand in long lines, **I am opting for an earlier start**. Please take note of this change! Holocaust Memorial Museum

Date: Monday, September 11, 2017

We will visit the Holocaust Museum in Farmington Hills, Michigan.

"The Holocaust is a history not only of evil, although the evil is undeniable, but also of great courage, strength and righteousness. The Holocaust Memorial Center Zekelman Family Campus has been teaching about the Holocaust and its legacy for more than 25 years, and its building, exhibits and programs have been receiving international accolades and heartfelt thanks from our millions of visitors. The Wall Street Journal, in a front-page article about our museum said in reference to the provocative nature of our building that our museum 'may be the most provocative museum of them all.' We are pleased that the architecture of this historic museum stirs the public consciousness of the unprecedented horrific crime of the Holocaust. Knowledge of the past is essential in order to avoid its repetition. 'The visit to the Holocaust Center changed our lives' is the most prevalent reaction following a visit to the HMC.

Witnessing the horrors perpetrated by the most educated society in Europe brings the rude awakening that education, including religious education, is no barrier against hatred and violence. The education that one absorbs in the HMC veers one towards constructive social consciousness. By highlighting and disseminating knowledge of the acts of the righteous and their constructive consequences, the HMC serves as a powerful antidote and countervailing force to the hatred and evil forces of destruction. The most effective way of combating hatred and evil is to strengthen, enhance, and enlarge the legion of the righteous."

This trip will include the motorcoach, museum admission, tour, a visit with a holocaust survivor and lunch. This year we plan to revisit the museum again after lunch to explore more on your own.

Preparations are already underway for the next **Passion Play** in the tiny Bavarian hamlet of Oberammergau. The shows in 2020 may seem distant but the excitement is already building for the next production. Demand for tickets is sure to be high and space on tours at a premium.

Back in 2010 Collette brought thousands of guests to Germany to enjoy this once-in-a-decade event. Building on years of experience, our team is hard at work developing new tours that showcase must-see European destinations and the epic Passion Play that depicts the life and death of Jesus.

It began all the way back in 1633. Oberammergau was suffering from the Bubonic Plague. The surviving villagers appealed for Divine intervention to save their families. They vowed that if God were to spare them, they would perform a Passion Play every ten years. They say not a single person fell victim to the Plague after that. Keeping their promise, the people of Oberammergau performed the first play in 1634 and have continued to do so throughout the centuries. Today, many of Oberammergau's residents still take part in this powerful work of art featuring dramatic performances, beautiful music and choral accompaniment.

The residents of Oberammergau will again perform The Passion Play in 2020. Collette will be there, sharing in the magnificence of this performance with several itineraries that showcase the charm and beauty of central Europe.

Although the play is in German, you won't have an issue understanding what is happening during the play, and the music is powerful. The music was written back in 1779 by Rochus Dedler. The music has influences of Mozart and Haydn. Some have compared it to being as romantic and expressive as pieces by Schubert or Weber. Although there have been slight adaptations over the years, it is still based on the original score. There is both an orchestra made up of 60 musicians and a choir which help bring all of the emotion and scenes to life.

The Passion Play operates for 5 months from May through October. Days of performances are every day except for Mondays and Wednesdays. The play runs for 5 - 5 ½ hours, starting at 2:30 pm and ending at 10:30 pm every day. It is only one play each day with an intermission of 3 hours for dinner.

I am looking at the trip called "Romantic Roads of Germany and Oberammergau" which includes some of the country's most iconic cities such as Berlin, Lubeck, Hamburg, Bremen, Hamelin, Kassel, Marburg, Wurzburg, and of course, Oberammergau. This 12 day trip will take us through many areas that were settings for Grimm's Fairy Tales and we'll see many castles.

Would you like to be there? Start thinking about this. The dates and prices won't be set until fall, but then we'll only have about 3 months to get deposits collected to reserve the seats. Even though the trip is 3 years away, this once in a decade event apparently sells out very quickly. I am planning for September of 2020. Insurance will be included!

Overnight Trips

Rooming lists for overnight trips need to be sent in a month prior to the trip. I cannot hold rooms if I do not have payment as the hotels will charge me for them. If I release the rooms, it may not be possible to get them back even if there is room on the bus. Special requests for a room need to be submitted with the room list. I cannot make handicap accessible rooms appear at the hotel upon check-in. If you need a room with a walk-in shower, grab bars in the bathroom, 1st floor, near elevator... let me know in advance. One issue we've had a few times lately is that hotels make a room "handicap accessible" by removing a bed to give a wheelchair more space to maneuver around. I need to know which is a higher priority... two beds OR handicap accessible.

For all trips that include a flight, it is very important that the name on the airline ticket matches the ID you plan to use. I must have the name as it is on the ID and your birthdate. Many people make me a copy of the passport or driver's license so I can make sure I've typed it correctly. Please consider doing this... no one sees them except me. If you do not have access to a copy machine, you are welcome to stop by the office during office hours and I will make a copy for you! It can cost \$200.00 to change the name on the ticket if it is wrong.
